FAQs:

Which course should I complete?

If you are a service provider or integration practitioner, complete ***The Effective Use of Interpreters***. If you are an interpreter or cultural mediator who serves as an interpreter, complete ***Introduction to Interpreting Skills***.

How long does it take to complete each course?

While each learner may spend a different amount of time completing the course, we recommend setting aside at least 30-45 minutes for each module (a total of at least an hour to 1.5 hours for the course). The modules contain several practical scenarios and knowledge checks, so it is important to take the time to work through each for the best learning outcomes.

I am unable to view the content. What should I do?

If you are viewing the e-learning on a PC, make sure you have the latest version of the Google Chrome browser installed. If you are viewing the e-learning on a Mac, make sure you have Safari 7 or later or the latest version of Google Chrome installed. We highly recommend that you complete the e-learning course on a computer in a quiet area for the best learning experience. If you choose to complete this course on a mobile device, you may be prompted to install the Articulate Mobile Player (this occurs for some, but not all Android users). If so, ensure that you are viewing the content on Android OS 4.1 or later after the player has been installed.
